Approximately 174 graduating students will receive Juris Doctor Degrees and five graduates will earn their LL.M. (Master of Laws) degrees.

Yana Loboda will be addressing the audience as Valedictorian.

The doors will open at 9 a.m. at Copley Symphony Hall, 750 B Street, San Diego. The graduation ceremony starts promptly at 10 a.m.

The Spring 2015 commencement speaker will be City Attorney Jan Goldsmith.

Goldsmith served as a Superior Court Judge from 1998 until his election as City Attorney in 2008. He had previously served in the California State Assembly for three terms, was the Mayor of Poway, and was an attorney in private practice.
