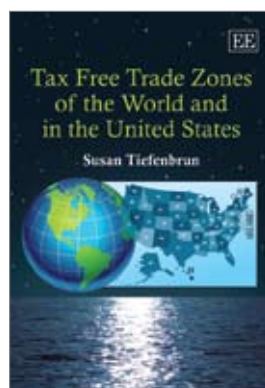
Tax Free Trade Zones of the World and in the United States
